Bringing absurdist British humour to the forefront, fringe festival star, Chris Gibbs performs *Antoine Fevel*, a deliciously funny show about a Dr. Watson-like sidekick. Continuing to bring in champion performers, the Society presents *Secrets... with Shawn Farquhar*, considered one of the world’s greatest magicians.
