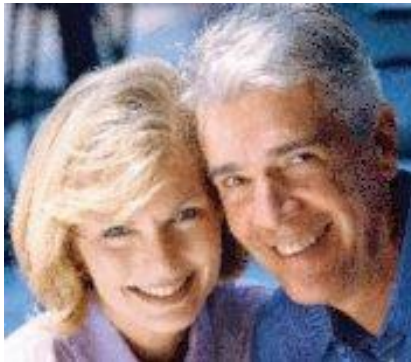

The World of Exotic Travel and Riverboat Cruising

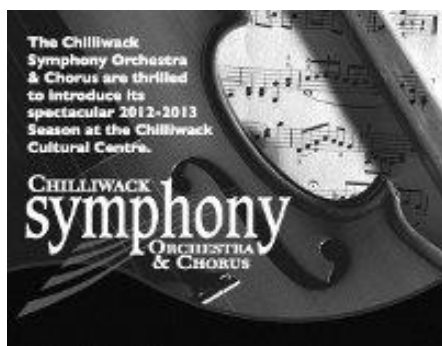

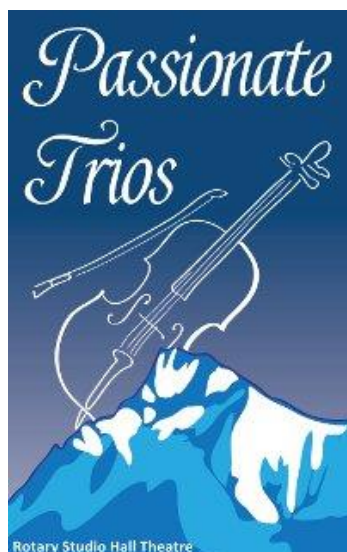

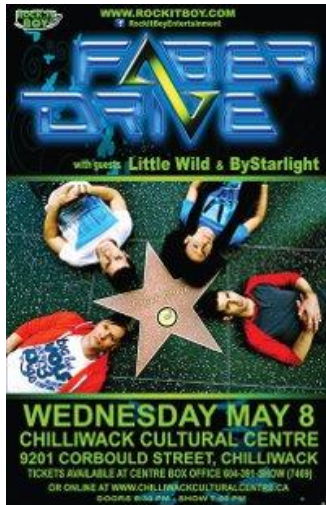
