The CMO Principal Soloist Series

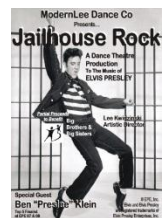

JAILHOUSE ROCK

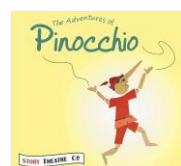
