Jennifer Lim started to play the piano before the age of five and she made her first public appearance one year later. She came into attention when she captured the Grand Prize at the Korean Times National Music Competition at age 8. In 1993 she was a top prize winner at the Canadian Music Competition in Montreal as well as the winner of Johanna Hodges International Piano Competition in California. In 1994, she was accepted to study at the Curtis Institute of Music on full scholarship with Peter Serkin as his only student. Upon graduation in 1998 she was awarded the Rachmaninoff/Festorazzi Prize. She completed her Master's degree at the Julliard School of Music in New York in 2000 as a protegee of the legendary Bella Davidovich. Ms. Lim also studied privately as a teenager with Anton Kuerti and Jane Coop.

CRIS DERKSEN

A rising star on the Canadian world, classical, folk, and electronica scenes, award-winning Aboriginal cellist **Cris Derksen** is known for building layers of sound into captivating performances. Her music braids the traditional and contemporary in multiple dimensions, weaving her traditional classical training and her aboriginal ancestry with new school electronics, creating genre defying music. Armed with a loop pedal and a drum machine, Cris is able to take her cello to new levels, becoming a one-woman-band who is equally at home making atmospheric music to chill to or filling a dance floor. Her critically acclaimed debut solo album, *The Cusp* (2010), won the 2011 Canadian Aboriginal Music Award for Instrumental Album of the Year, and was nominated for a Western Canadian Music Award, and an Aboriginal People's Choice Award. Since the release of *The Cusp*, Cris has been on an upward trajectory, her National profile is rising as she becomes a fixture on the Canadian Folk Festival Circuit.



Beyond the Double Dip

This specialized workshop is intended for clay students who wish to explore a wide range of surface decoration techniques to add new dimensions to their works.

A range of decorating techniques will be addressed at all levels of pottery development, from the wet clay forming process using slips and texturing with tools or chemicals, through various methods of decorating in the leather hard and bone dry stages, on to glazing bisqued pieces. During the first session students will work with wet, leatherhard and greenware surfaces. During the second session students will work on bisque ware and finish pieces from the first session. Previous clay experience is preferred, but not required.
