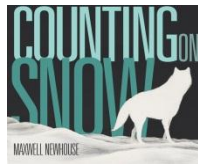
#### EXCITING ANNOUNCEMENT:

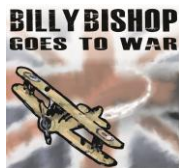

### **BILLY BISHOP GOES TO WAR**

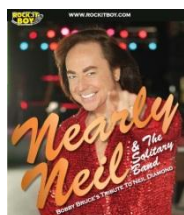

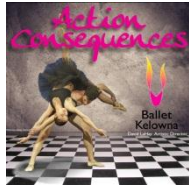
