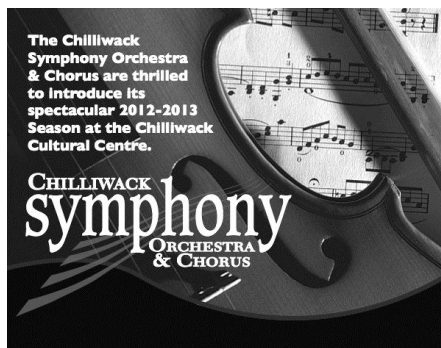

RAIN MOUNTAIN CLASSICAL MUSIC SERIES

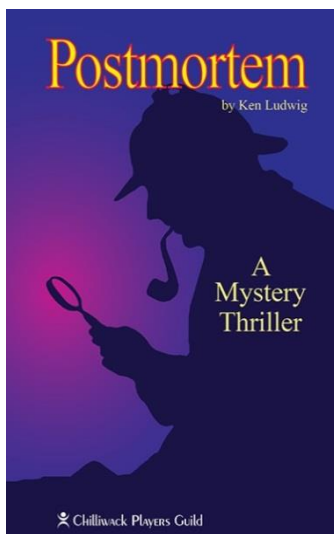


Enjoy the world of piano trios in this program presenting two Romantic Era masterpieces. The great composer friends, Johannes Brahms and Robert Schumann, both created amazing work inspired by their affection for the same woman, Schumann's wife, Clara. Schumann's Piano Trio No. 3, Op. 110 – composed two years before his wife's heart was divided by the arrival of the young Brahms – precedes Brahms's Piano Trio No. 1, Op. 8 – composed as Schumann's life and mind began unraveling. Brahms revised this composition 40 years later when the passions of the moment had cooled and he could reflect on the tragedies that had transpired. Lose yourself in the passionate tones of this double-header of Romantic masterpieces as the emotional turmoil of these 3 people is brought to life through classical music.
