### **SOLD DOUBT**

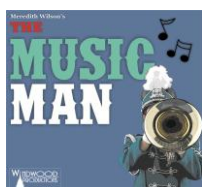

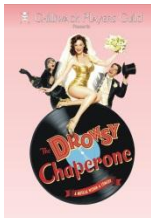
