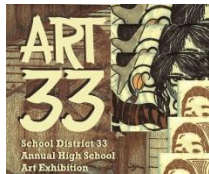

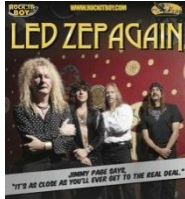

MOTHER'S DAY WITH PATSY CLINE

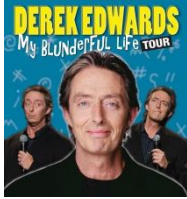

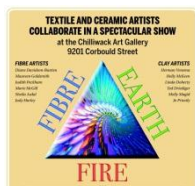

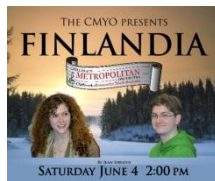
