Hijinks ensue when the Angel grudgingly allows John to re-live the last 12 hours before his death – on the condition that he tells his ex-fiancé, Cassie, how he really feels about her leaving him at the altar.

Caliban: House Sitter is the story of actor Andrew, who offers to look after a friend's lakeside home for the weekend, expecting nothing more exciting than a few days rest and relaxation. A visit from Claire, his friend's attractive neighbour, changes all that. Love, sex, fear, and Shakespeare duke it out in this fascinating conflict of archetypes. 
