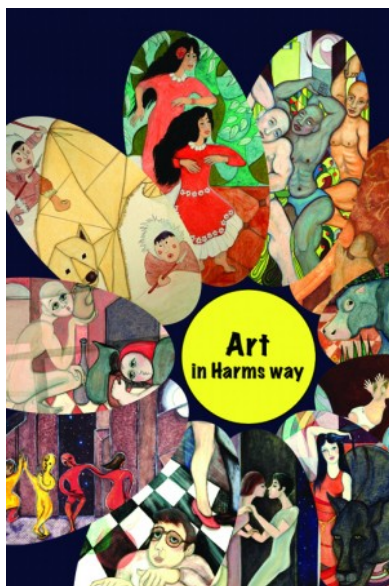
First Exhibition of the 2015 Season!
