Chainmail

Adult Class – Workshop

The ancient art of chainmail is something that has been used in jewelry for hundreds of years, we will learn the basics to create a unique bracelet.

This 2 hour workshop will go over everything you will need to know to start creating chainmail jewelry. We will discuss different types of wire to use, tools necessary, how to make a good ring for chainmail and how to measure the rings properly. Once we have the basics we will put it all together in a simple but beautiful bracelet that you can show off to your friends. Any skill level.

Glass Beads

The ancient art of creating beautiful glass beads with a torch and glass rods.

This is a 6 week introductory course in the ancient art of Flameworking or as it has been called in the past Lampworking. You will learn everything from basic torch safety through forming a basic bead, tool use and how to set up your own home studio. The different types of glass will be discussed at length and experimented with to fully understand the reactive properties of certain glasses, and colours. By the end of the 6 week course you will feel very comfortable with the tools involved, the torch and glass and feel confident about the beads you are creating.
