## *Glazes – Getting a great finish*

### **Adult Class – 2 sessions**

**Date:** *October 7 & 14, 2014*

**Time:** *Tuesdays, 6:30 to 9:00pm*

**Instructor:** *Holly McKeen*

**Cost:** *\$90 includes glazes and test tiles*

***Learn how cone 6 electric fired glazes work, plus how to mix, layer and apply glazes for great effects.***

This course will offer a better understanding of how to create different colours, textures and effects in oxidation pottery glazes. Learn more about our glazes in the Centre's Clay Lab, and how different glazes interact. Understand how to mix glaze ingredients, and apply them to achieve special effects. Using a large number of test tiles, students will create glaze colouring, texture and layering samples that will show how various effects are achieved, and how application/thickness and layering affects the results. Also learn tips and techniques on how kiln firing impacts glaze results. Also, bring your questions for expert trouble-shooting – Our Instructor is well known for her glazing expertise.

This is an “all about wire” workshop. We will tackle various techniques and you will learn to make jump rings, head and eye pins, ear wires, make bead dangles and spiral charms. At the end of the class you will be able to construct a necklace, bracelet and earrings from start to finish with nothing but wire, hand tools and a few beads. We will also explore finishing techniques such as a basic patina using Liver of Sulphur and polishing using a tumbler. No previous knowledge with wire is required.
