Glass Beads 1

Adult Class – 6 sessions

Date: September 21, 28, October 5, 19, 26 & November 2, 2014

Time: Sundays, 1:00 - 3:00PM

Instructor: Alicia Champ

Cost: \$245 materials included

This is a 6 week introductory course in the ancient art of Flameworking or as it has been called in the past; Lampworking. You will learn everything from basic torch safety through to forming a basic bead, tool use and how to set up your own home studio. The different types of glass will be discussed at length and experimented with to fully understand the reactive properties of certain glasses and colours. By the end of the 6 week introductory course you will feel very comfortable with the tools involved, the torch and glass and feel confident about the beads you are creating.

Acrylic Painting
