The Gin Game is a two-person, two-act play that premiered in September 1976 and won the 1978 Pulitzer Prize for Drama. It features two residents at a nursing home who strike up an acquaintance, as neither seems to have any friends at the home. They seem to get along very well and after a while Weller offers to teach Fonsia how to play Gin Rummy. While playing their Gin games, they engage in lengthy conversations about their families and their lives in the outside world. Gradually, each conversation becomes a battle, much like the ongoing Gin games. It becomes clear why neither has many friends as the bitterness of their lives is revealed. Although the play is very dramatic, it features some lovely moments and is sprinkled with tremendously funny interactions.

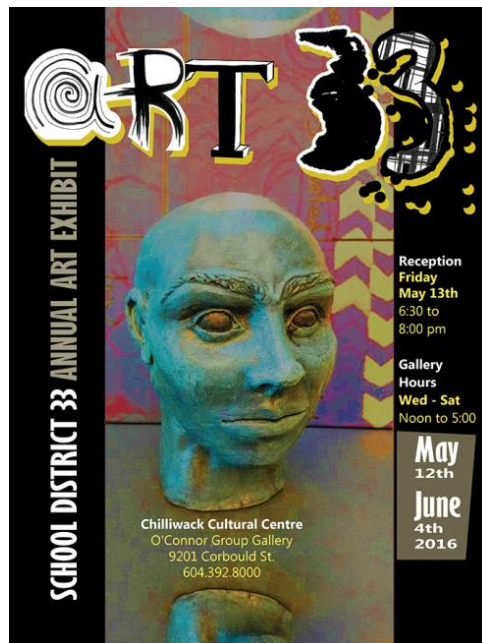
