They are delighted to have Masters of Ceremony: Actor Patrick Gallagher and CBC Radio Host Margaret Gallagher on hand and Professor of Linguistics, Dr Joseph Gallagher will be giving a moving recitation. The Gallagher family are former Chilliwack residents and Joseph was an active member of the Chilliwack Players Guild. 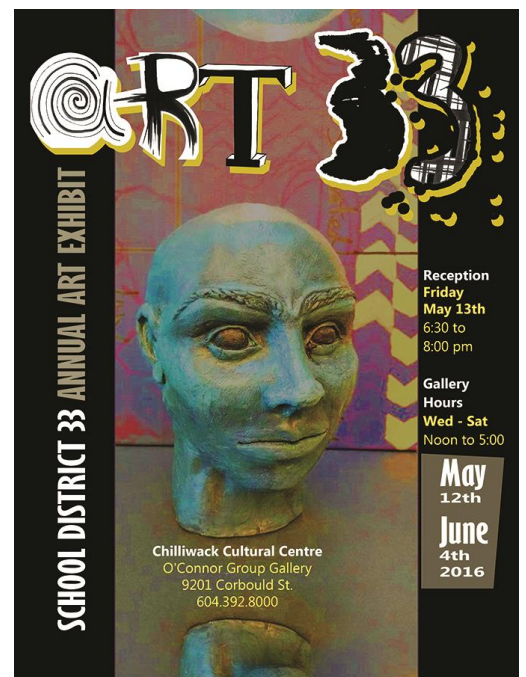
Chilliwack Visual Artists Association presents

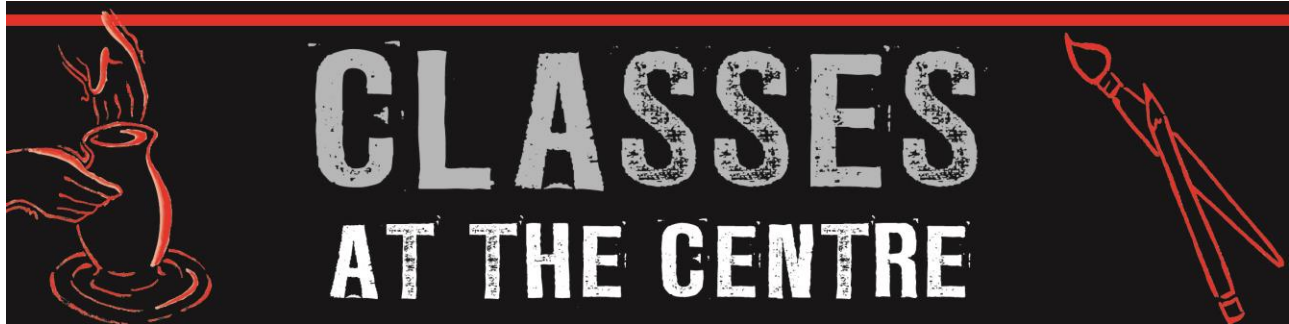
