A Visionary Artist, another term for self taught, works with acrylic on canvas, she uses bright images, using abstract areas to explore feelings expressed by means of colour.

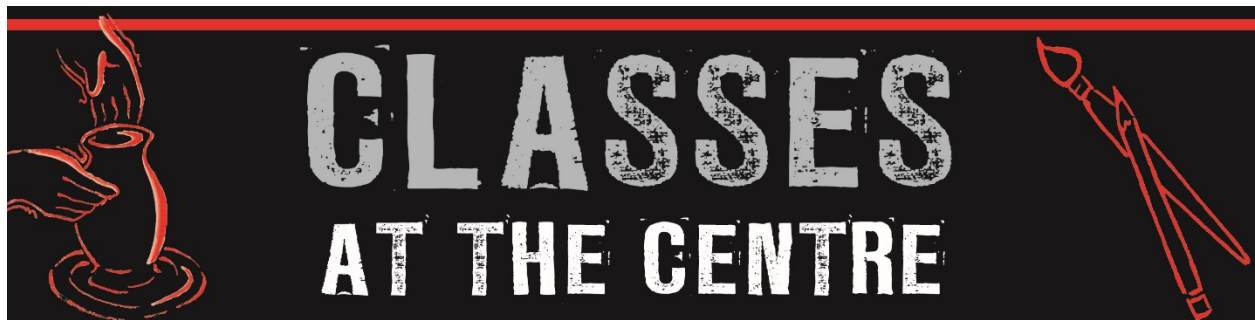
