In October 2007, the 10th anniversary of John's passing, Jim brought a landmark concert to the stage in Aspen, Colorado. It included many of John Denver's former band members, some of them for the first time in a tribute show. Curry's philosophy is summed up in the words, "These songs blend the images of our natural earth with a love for each other as people. The care you give to someone you love is the best care. Making that connection to our earth and to each other is the goal."

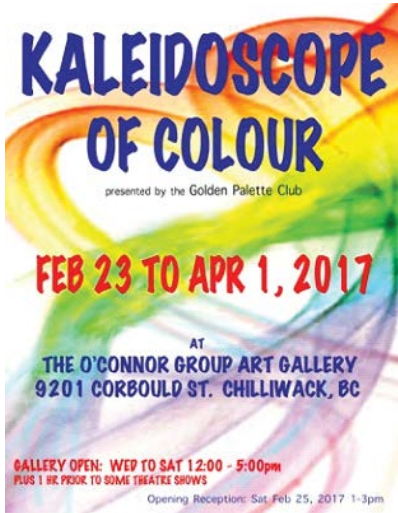
