The BIG O was unmistakable with his trademark sunglasses, his distinctive, powerful voice, his complex compositions and the dark emotional ballads we all love. From 1960 to '64 Roy Orbison landed 22 songs on the Billboard Top 40, including "Only The Lonely", "Crying", and "Oh, Pretty Woman". His impassioned voice, bridging the gap between baritone and tenor, coupled with his signature arrangements ensured the charting of the hits "Dream Baby", "Ooby Dooby", "Blue Angel", "Blue Bayou", "You Got It" and "In Dreams". As a part of THE TRAVELING WILBURYS Orbison brought us "End of the Line", "Handle With Care" and "Last Night". Tragically, his life was cut short, leaving us only the music.

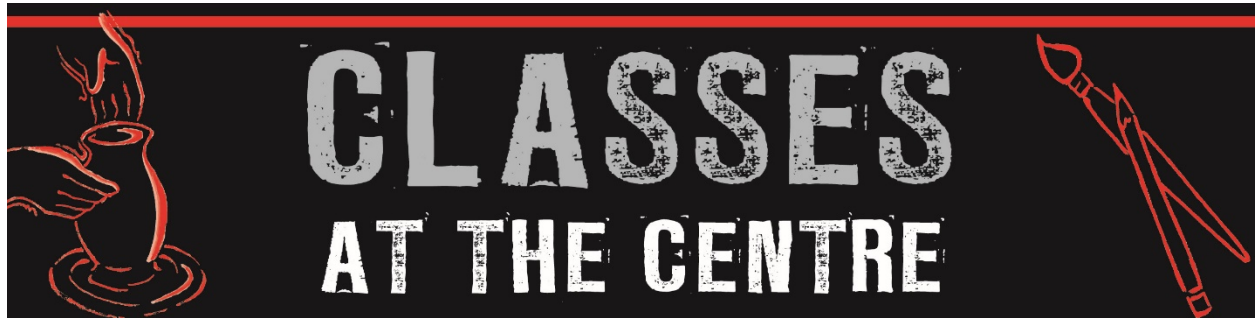

Go beyond the basic “double dip” of pottery glazing!

There are so many ways to decorate your pottery creations at all stages of the process, from tools for texturing during the wet clay stage to methods of decorating in the leather hard and bone dry stages. Techniques covered will include sgraffito, brushwork, printing, carving, roulettes, stamping, stains, resists, slips and more. Students will be provided with wet, leatherhard, greenware, and bisque tiles for practice, but may bring bisque pieces created in the open studio to work on as well.

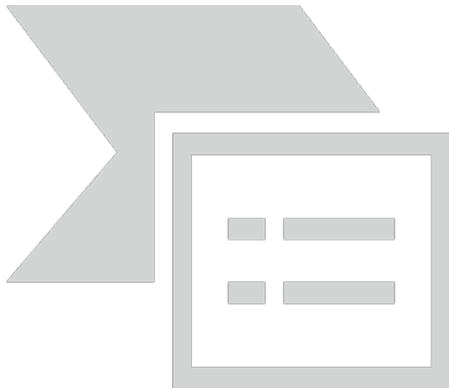
