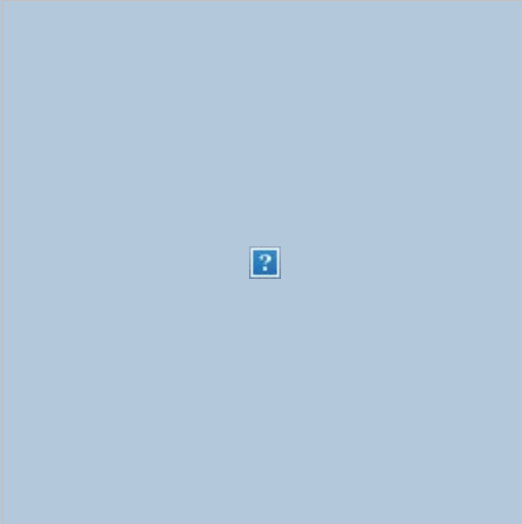

**The ability to draw the human figure is an essential art form and vital to those who wish to continue to develop their observational drawing skills.**

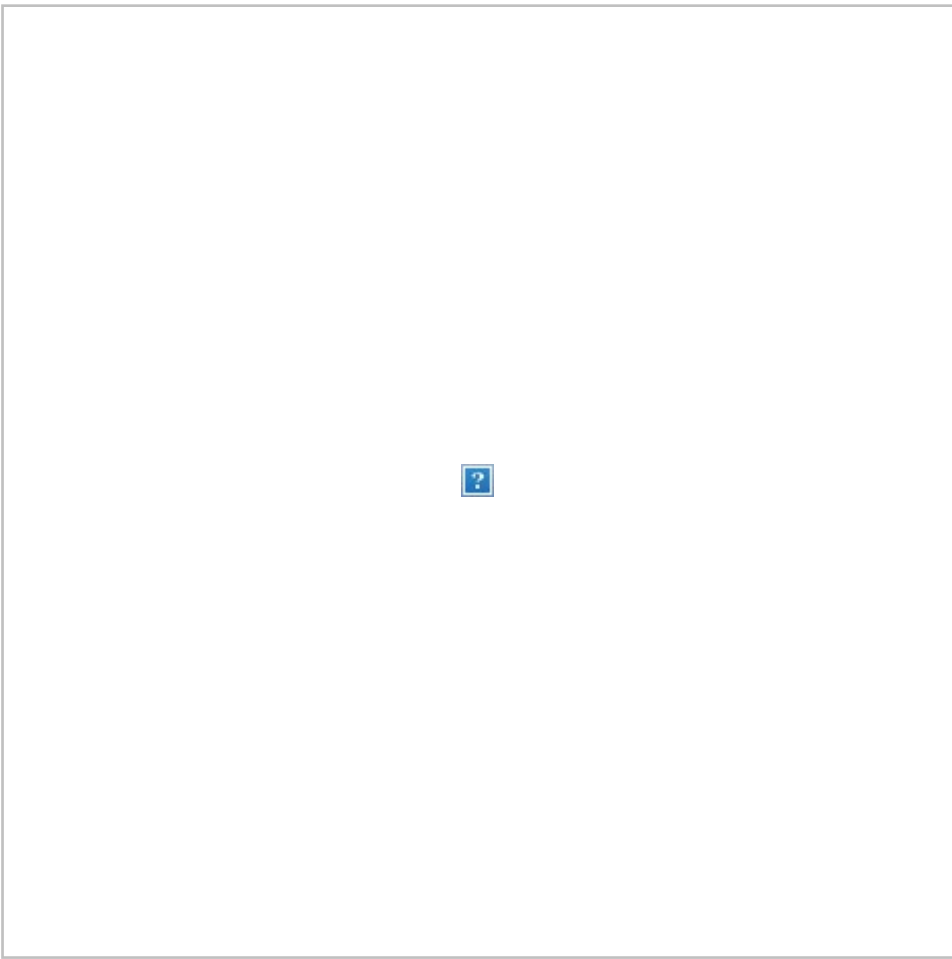
