

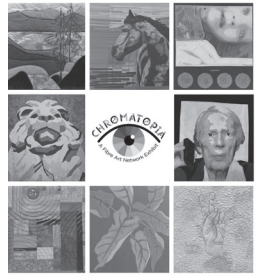

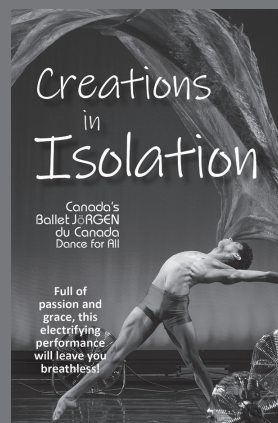
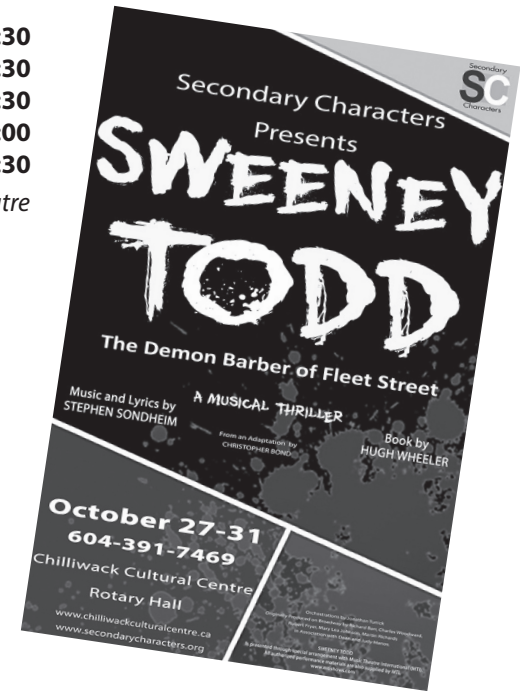

Safety Plan

As of September 13, 2021, by order of the Provincial Health Officer (PHO), proof of vaccination is required to access some events at The Centre where expected capacity will exceed 50 people. Patrons aged 19 years and older will also need to provide one piece of government ID.

Starting September 13, you must have at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine. By October 24, you must be fully vaccinated. The requirement is in place until January 31, 2022 and could be extended. The requirement applies to all people born in 2002 or earlier (19+). We ask that you arrive 30 minutes prior to the start of your event and come ready to present your government-issued ID and provincial App and/or government issued print out of vaccination.

Masks are required in all public indoor settings for all people born in 2009 or earlier (12+).
