With the help of Spa:th (Bear), Sqeweqs (Raven), and Sasq'ets (Sasquatch), Kw'at'el embarks on a journey to earn Th'owxiya's forgiveness.

The history of Th'owxiya for the Kwantlen people is deep. She is a mythological being that has been used to teach children to listen and to not venture


