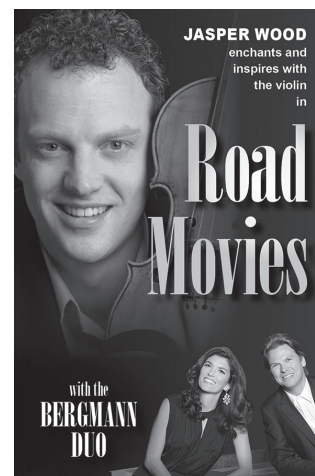
## BEST OF THE VANCOUVER INTERNATIONAL MOUNTAIN FILM FESTIVAL
