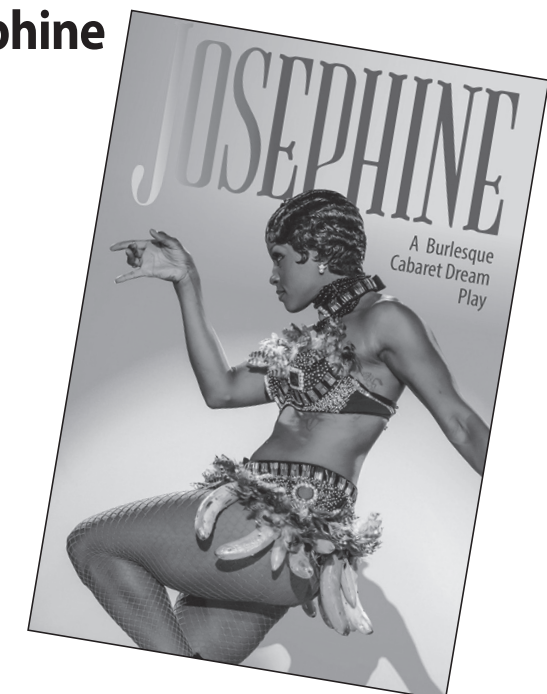
## Uplifting, engaging and perfectly dramatic, Josephine is cabaret and theatre like you've never seen!

### Writer's Workshop Wednesdays

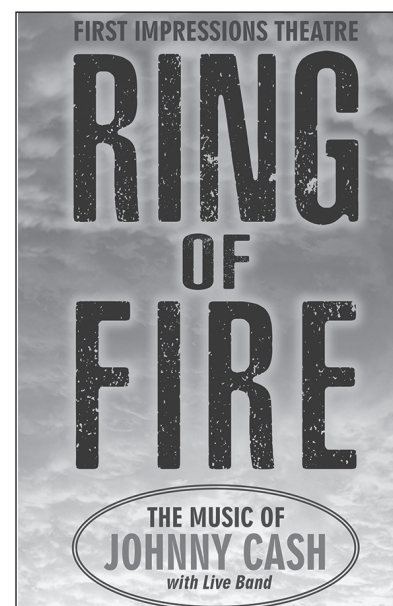
