Registration Information:

The Centre's flexible schedule lets you customize your child's camp experience. Register for a single class, two per day, or a full day all week of fun and creativity!

Each day is split into five time slots, with two class options taking place in each time slot. Pick one option and your child will take part in that activity at that time for the full week.

Classes are \$60 each for the whole week!
\$50 each for the shorter week.

Class descriptions are listed after the weekly schedules.

Choose one class and your child will take part in that activity, at that time, for the full week.

Choose Castles & Quests for 5 to 7 year olds and they will take that class from 9:00 to 10:00 on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday!

Parent Information:

Dropping off:

A child may be picked up by a responsible adult at the parents' discretion. Please provide the name of the person and their relationship to your child at the time of drop off. Children will not be released without written permission.

Lunch:

Lunch occurs between 12:10 and 12:40 pm. Students who are staying over the lunch period are supervised in one of the classrooms. Lunch supervision requires pre-registration. If a student is staying for lunch, we ask that they bring their own nut-free lunch.

Pick up:

Students should be picked up within 10 minutes of class finishing. Before leaving the building, students must be signed out at the registration desk and leave their nametag with staff at the desk.

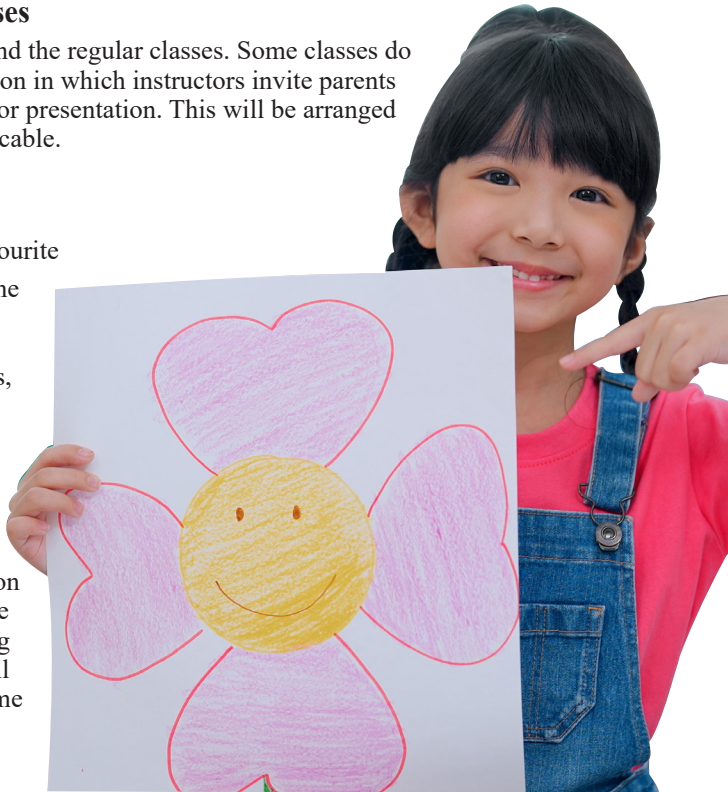
Students that are picked up more than 10 minutes late or dropped off 10 minutes early with no parent supervision will be charged a \$35 fee.

Staying to watch classes

Adults are not able to attend the regular classes. Some classes do conclude with a final session in which instructors invite parents to observe a performance or presentation. This will be arranged with the instructor if applicable.

Fantastic Fridays:

Each Friday, student's favourite projects are displayed in the hallway by the administration office. In performance-based classes, parents are welcome to attend a short demonstration of what students have worked on in class that week. This will happen in the last ten minutes of each class on camp Fridays. Students are asked to bring a box or bag on Fridays to make sure all of their art projects go home on that day.



Parent Information:

What to bring:

- a nut-free snack if they are staying for more than two classes
- a water bottle
- a box/bag on the Friday to bring their artwork home

Students should not bring unnecessary or valuable belongings such as toys, games, money, etc. Students should “dress for mess” and movement and should also be wearing close-toed shoes – no flip-flops or open toed sandals. This is for students’ safety as well as keeping nice clothes nice.

Lost Property:

Your child is responsible for all items and belongings they bring to camp. For this reason The Centre advises that children not bring items of value with them. For any questions regarding lost property, contact The Centre Box Office.

Photography:

Centre marketing staff may take photos of classes to be used exclusively for The Centre’s promotional materials. Parents may fill out a media release waiver if they do not wish for their child to be photographed. These photos will not be loaned or sold to any outside party.

Health concerns:

Prior to the start of camp, parents/guardians are required to inform camp staff of health concerns, including food allergies or support needs, in an email. Camp staff are not permitted to administer any medication other than Epi-pens. If medication is required during the day, parents/guardians must make arrangements to come in or have a designated adult come in and administer. Epi-pens must be on the student’s person at all times OR clearly labelled and left with sign-in staff.

Accessibility limitations:

We are committed to making our art education programming accessible to all. However, due to limited capacity, some restrictions may apply. We ask that parents/guardians email the Arts & Education Programs Manager at: trischa@chilliwackculturalcentre.ca regarding support needs. If your child has a one-to-one support at school, we are not able to provide that type of support, and a support person must accompany your child to camp.

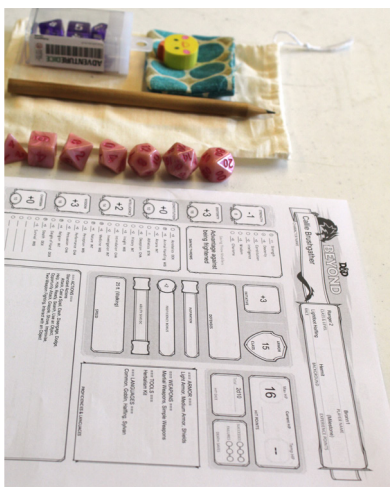
